Tyre Park	£2,475	Construction of a tyre park in an area under-used within the grounds. Particularly useful for the newly established wrap-around care facility within school.	To encourage "reluctant" children to engage in meaningful physical activity. To provide opportunity for children in before and after school clubs to engage in physical activity.
Basketball posts and football goals	£8,436	High quality long lasting basketball nets and football goals were installed in the playground.	This has encouraged more children to participate in sustained physical activity during play times and lunch times
Sports coaching, teacher CPD and sports clubs	£3,500	A trained sports coach to support children with SEN children during lessons and engage children in sport outside of school.	To continue to support the PE curriculum within school and encourage children to participate in sport as an extra-curricular activity.
